1 This Court, having read and considered the papers submitted by the parties,  
2 and finding good cause therefor, orders that the motion to dismiss pursuant to  
3 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure section 12(b)(6) filed by defendant Internet  
4 Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers is hereby GRANTED without leave  
5 to amend as to plaintiff VeriSign, Inc.'s ("VeriSign") amended first claim for relief  
6 for violation of section 1 of the Sherman Act, amended second claim for relief for  
7 injunctive relief for breach of contract, amended third claim for relief for damages  
8 for breach of contract, amended fourth claim for relief for interference with  
9 contractual relations, amended fifth claim for relief for specific performance of  
10 contract and injunctive relief, and amended sixth claim for relief for damages for  
11 breach of contract. VeriSign's amended first, second, third, fourth, fifth, and sixth  
12 causes of action are hereby dismissed with prejudice because none of these claims  
13 for relief states a claim upon which relief may be granted.
