ICANN has conducted a review of MuseDoma's publication of a signed .MUSEUM zone file. ICANN has not identified any significant competition or security and stability issues with this limited administrative introduction. We understand that MuseDoma will continue to cooperate and consult with the appropriate ICANN staff and experts on details of the full implementation of DNSSEC in .MUSEUM, and that MuseDoma will be submitting a subsequent request through the Registry Services Evaluation Process to make DNSSEC available to subzones within the .MUSEUM sTLD and to the sponsored community.

We look forward to further information on these efforts.
