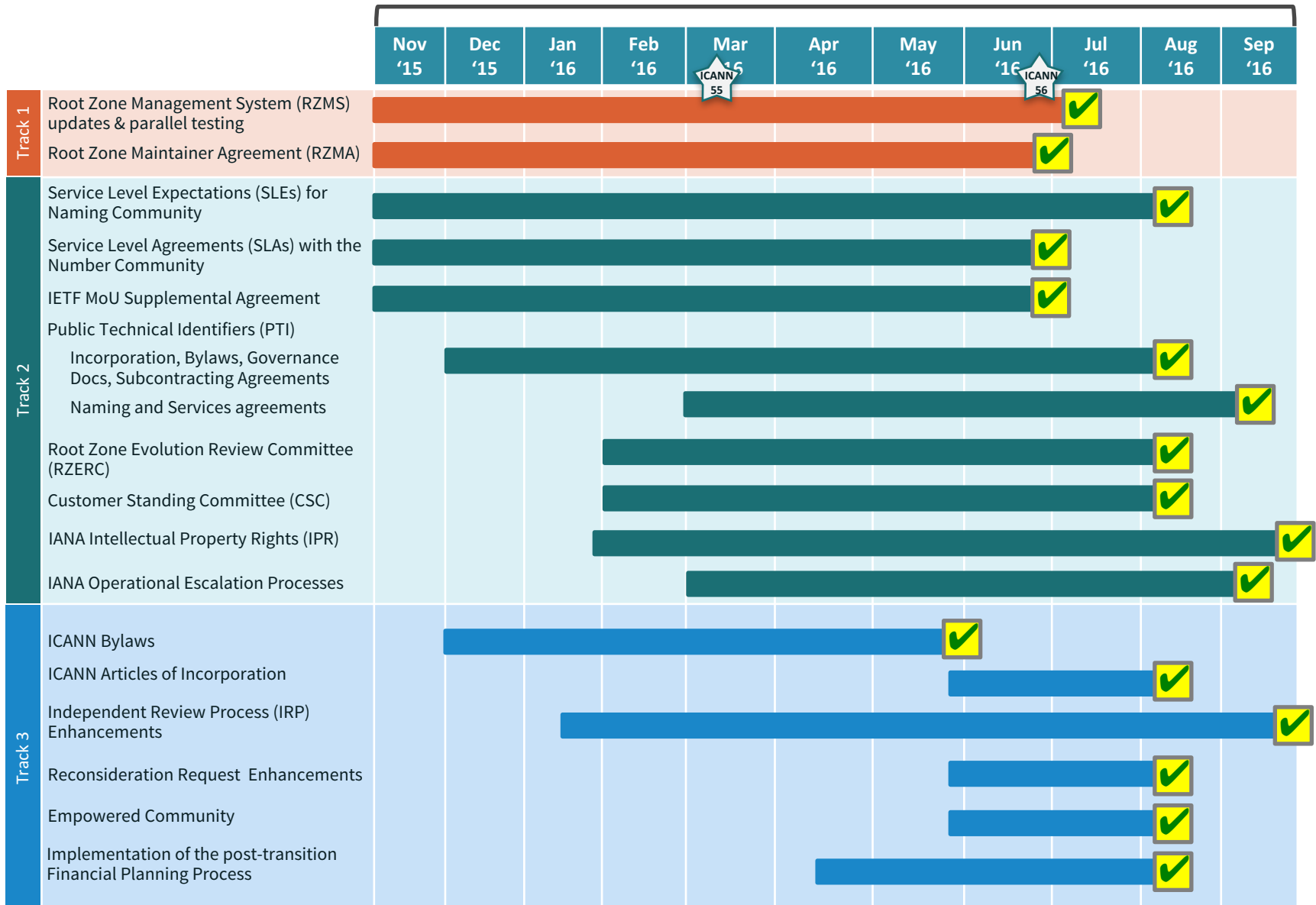

# Internet Technology / Office of the CTO Update

- ⦿ Work on the root **Key Signing Key (KSK)** roll project is under way and seven public presentations were given to increase awareness of the project.
- ⦿ **Identifier Technologies Health Indicators project** - held a workshop in Washington, D.C (September) with Naming community to discuss health metrics. Outreach to the Numbering and Protocol Parameter communities continue.
- ⦿ Dedicated research analysis environment with one petabyte of storage deployed and now receiving and storing traffic from **L-root and B-root**.
- ⦿ Participated in **anti-abuse and other security, stability, and resiliency training and engagement** sessions around the world with a focus last quarter in Central and Eastern Europe.
- ⦿ Second **Security, Stability, and Resiliency (SSR2) Review** - ICANN received 66 applications. Final selections will be made soon and the review team kickoff is planned to occur near the end of 2016.
- ⦿ ICANN's Office of the CTO continues to work with the technical community by engaging in, and realigning activities to support ICANN's mission, role, and responsibility within the technical ecosystem.

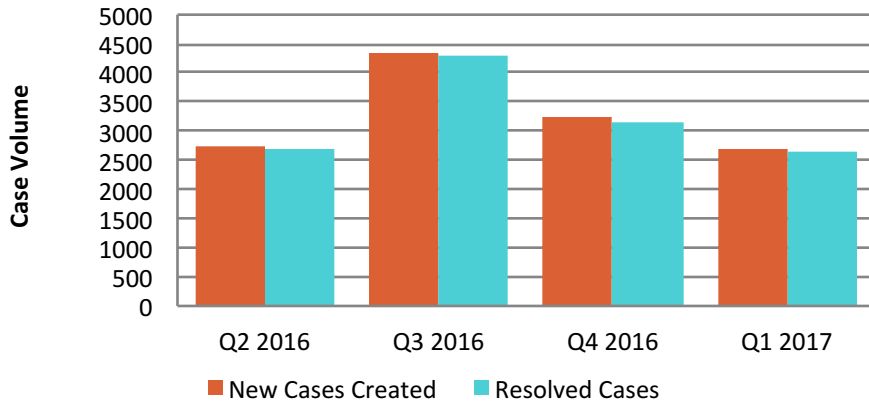

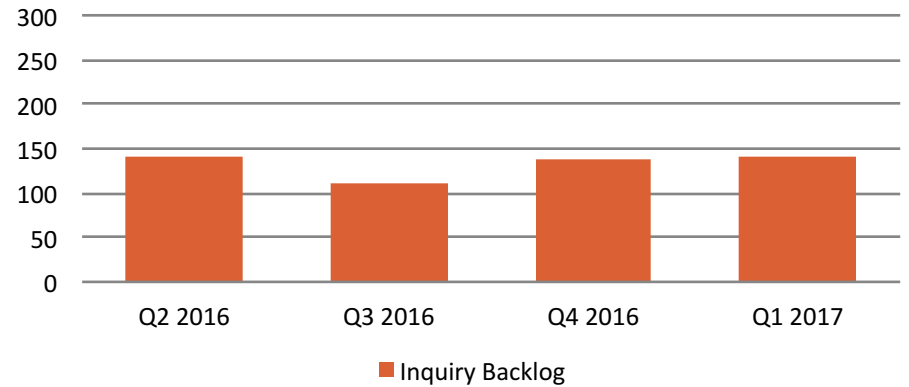
## Case Volume Trending

Cases Created & Resolved



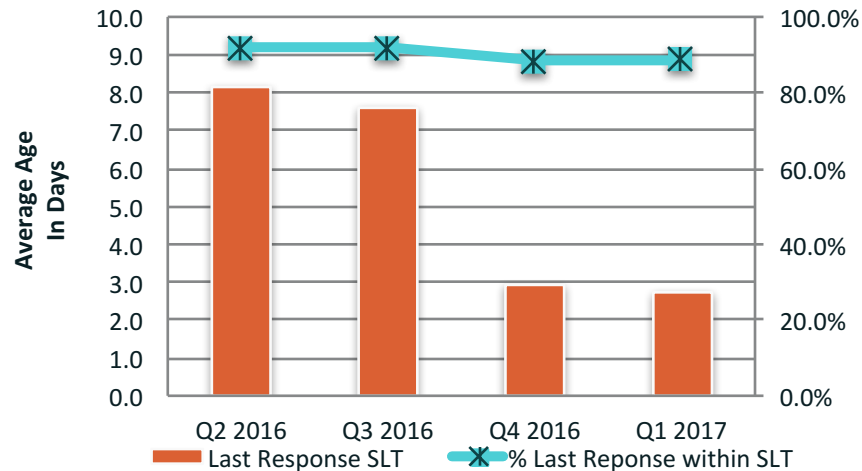
## Case Backlog

Quarter End Volume Trending



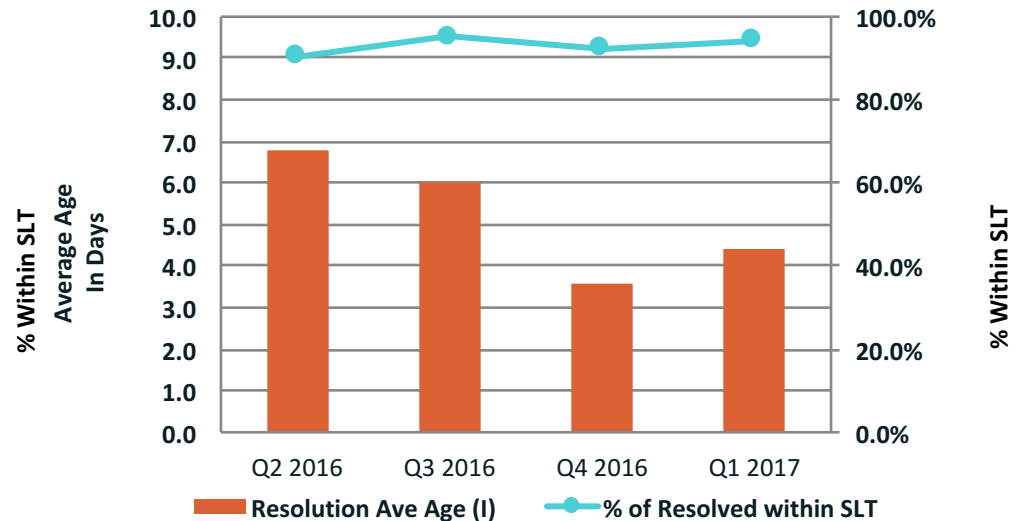

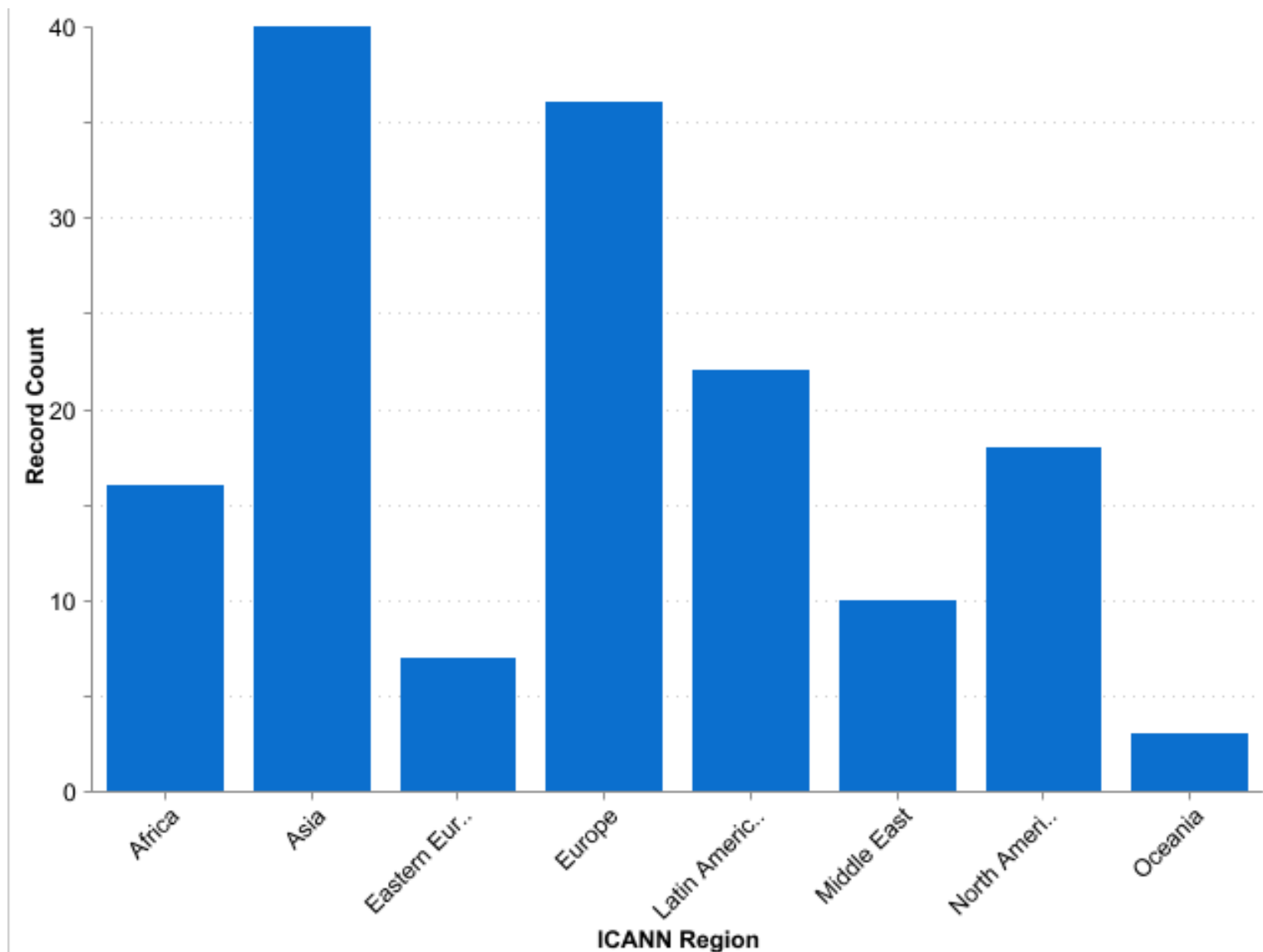

### New gTLD Subsequent Procedures - Work to Date

- Considering a set of 6 overarching issues:
  - Additional new gTLDs in the future.
  - Categorization or differentiation of gTLDs (for example brand, geographical, or supported/community) in ongoing new gTLD mechanisms.
  - Future new gTLDs assessed in "rounds."
  - Predictability should be maintained or enhanced without sacrificing flexibility. In the event changes must be introduced into the new gTLD Application process, the disruptive effect to all parties should be minimized.
  - Community engagement in new gTLD application processes.
  - Limiting applications in total and/or per entity during an application window.
- Community Comment 1 – seeking input from the community on these subjects

- WG considering initial preliminary conclusions

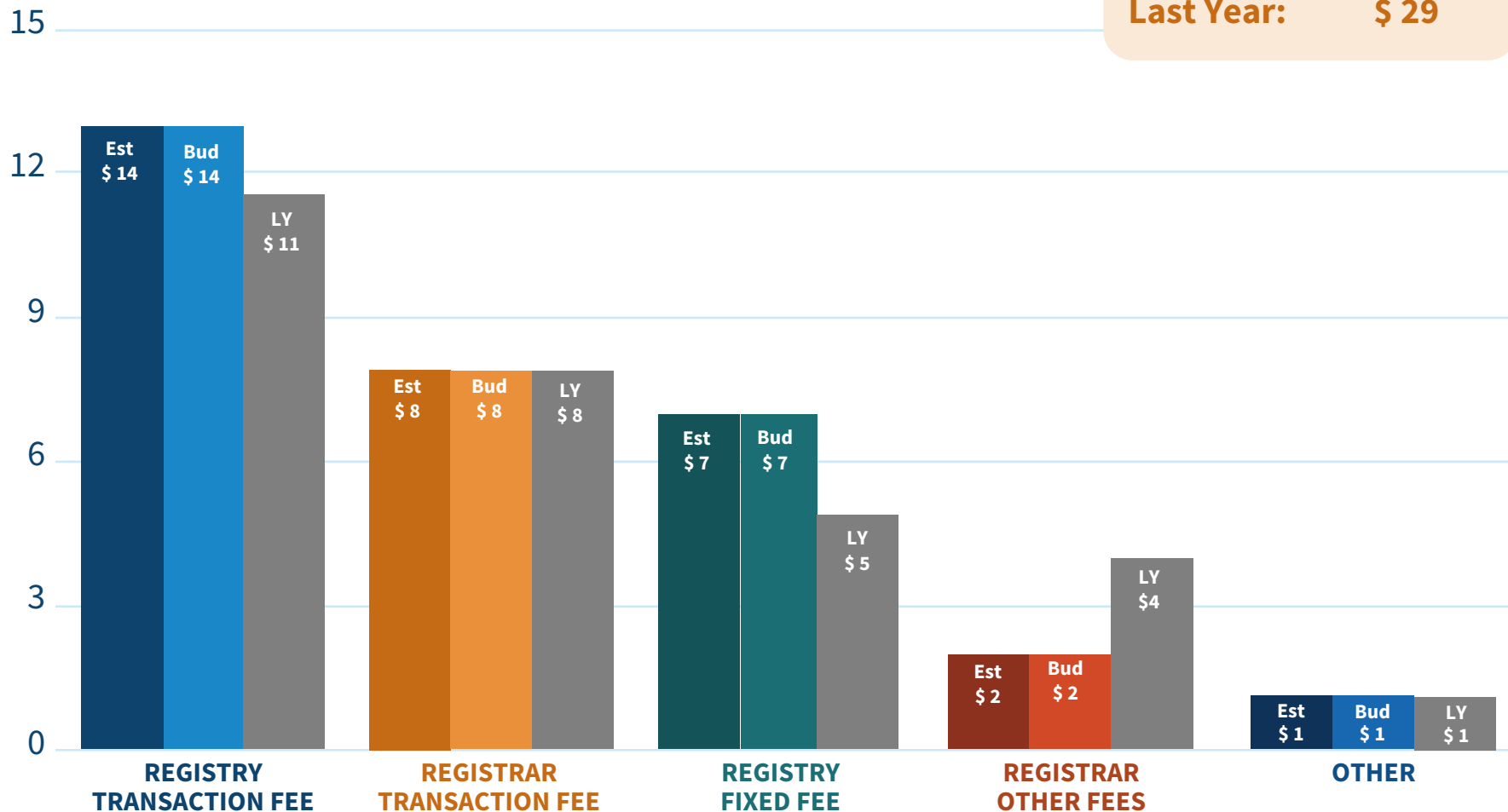

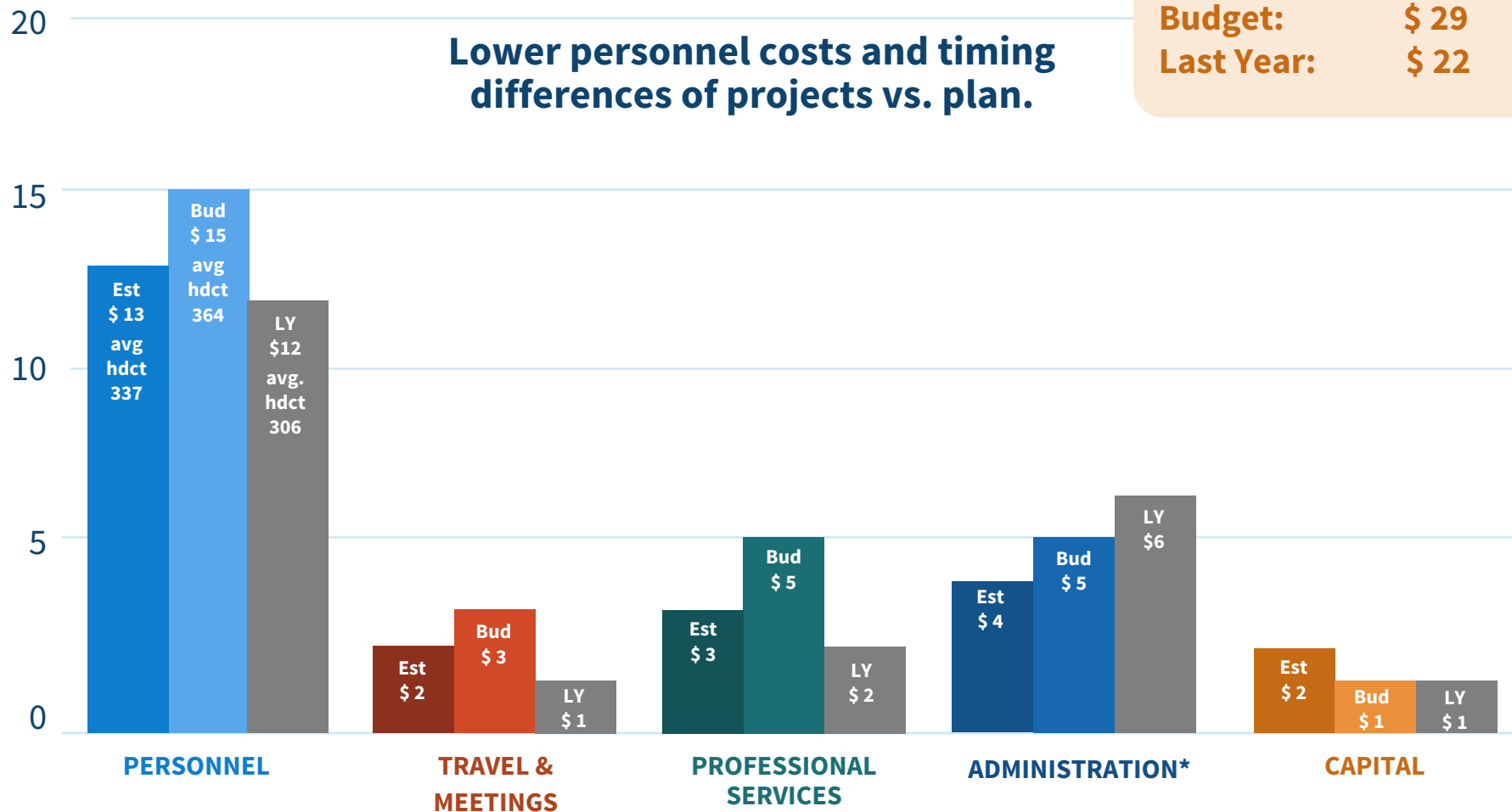

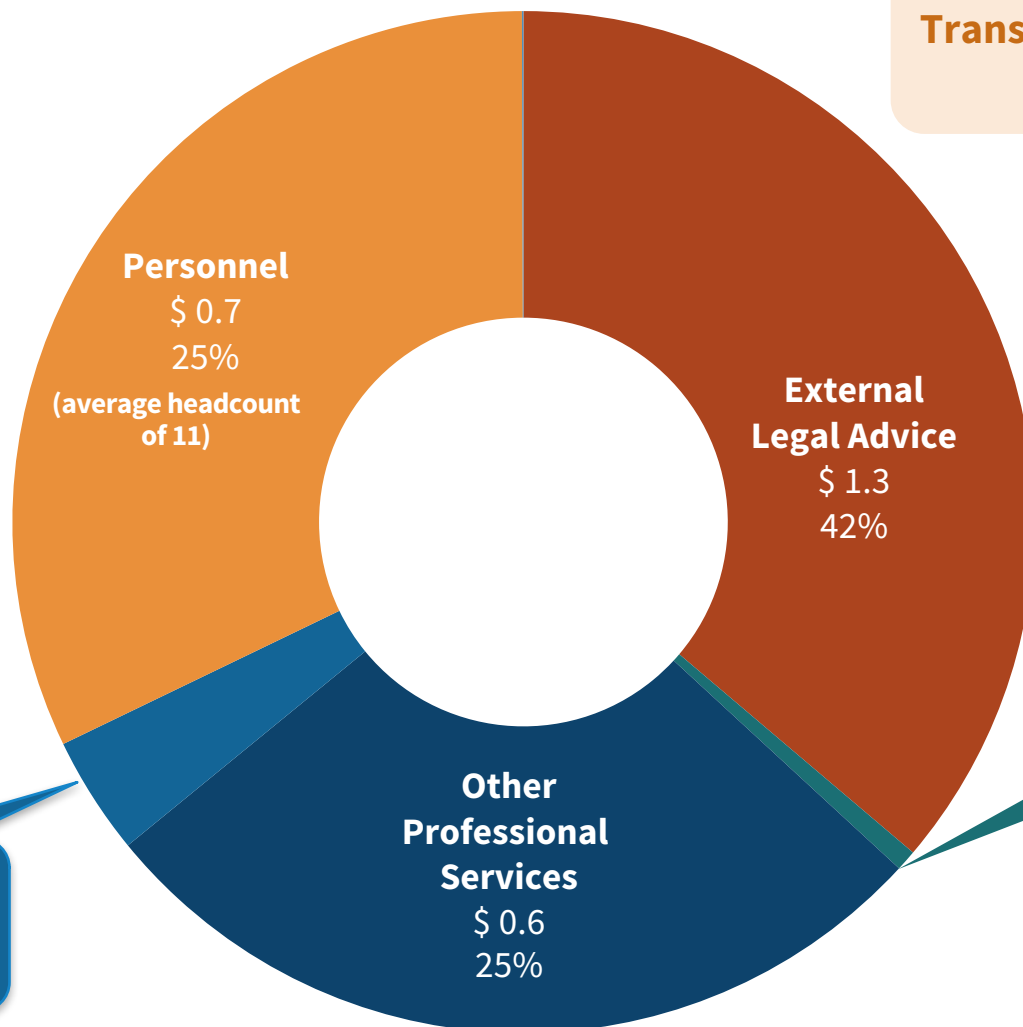

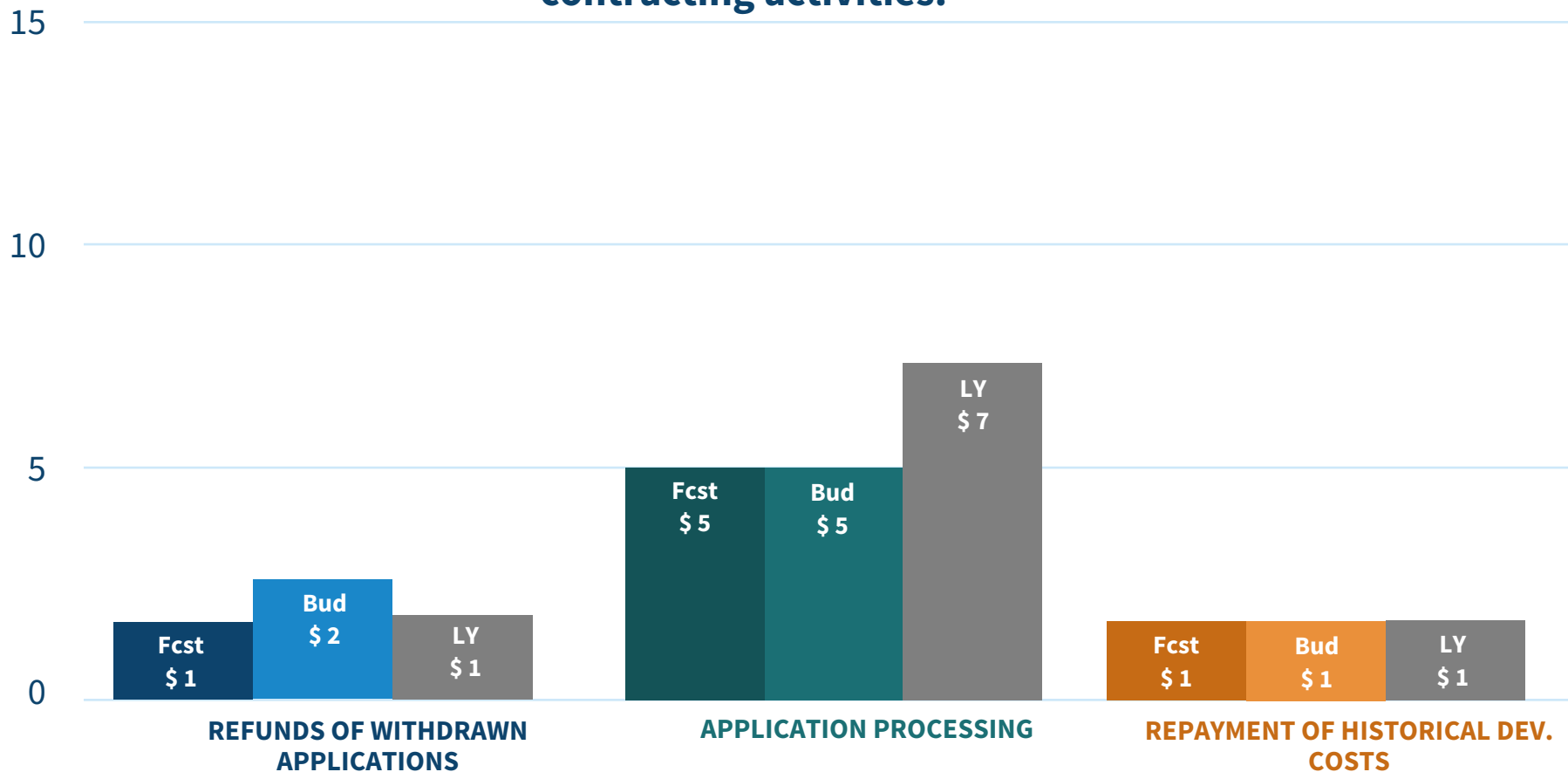

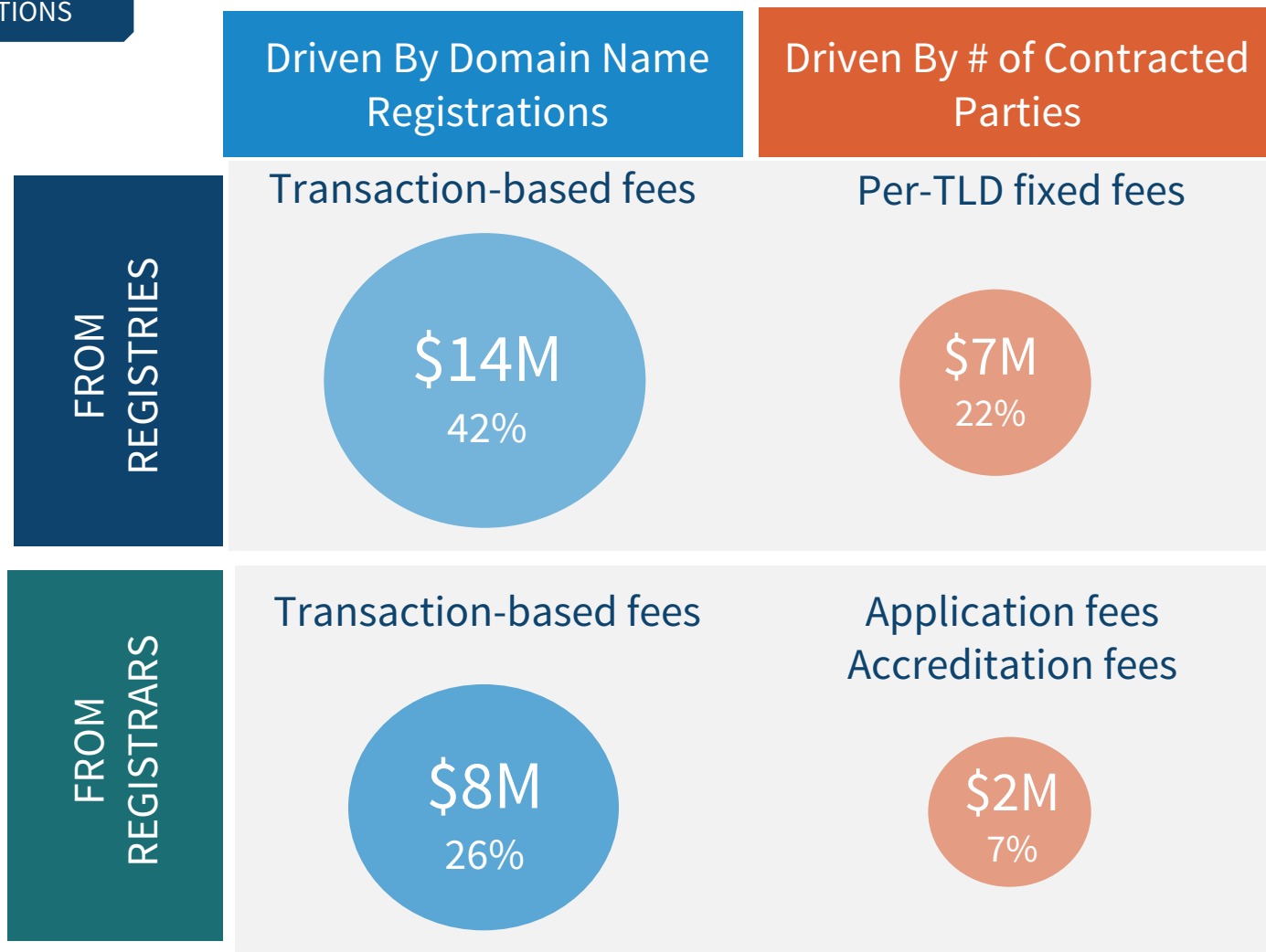
# Total ICANN Overview

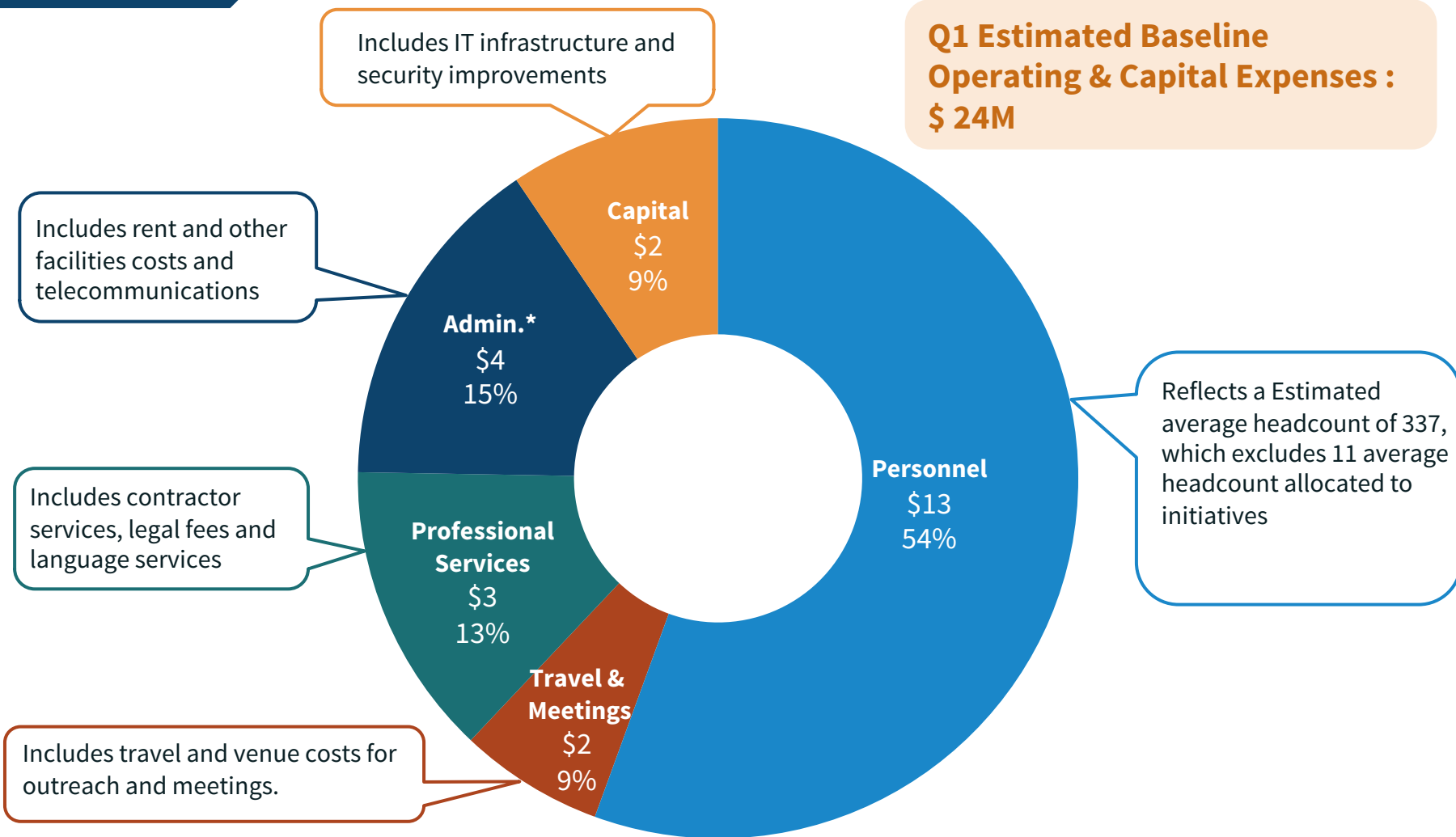

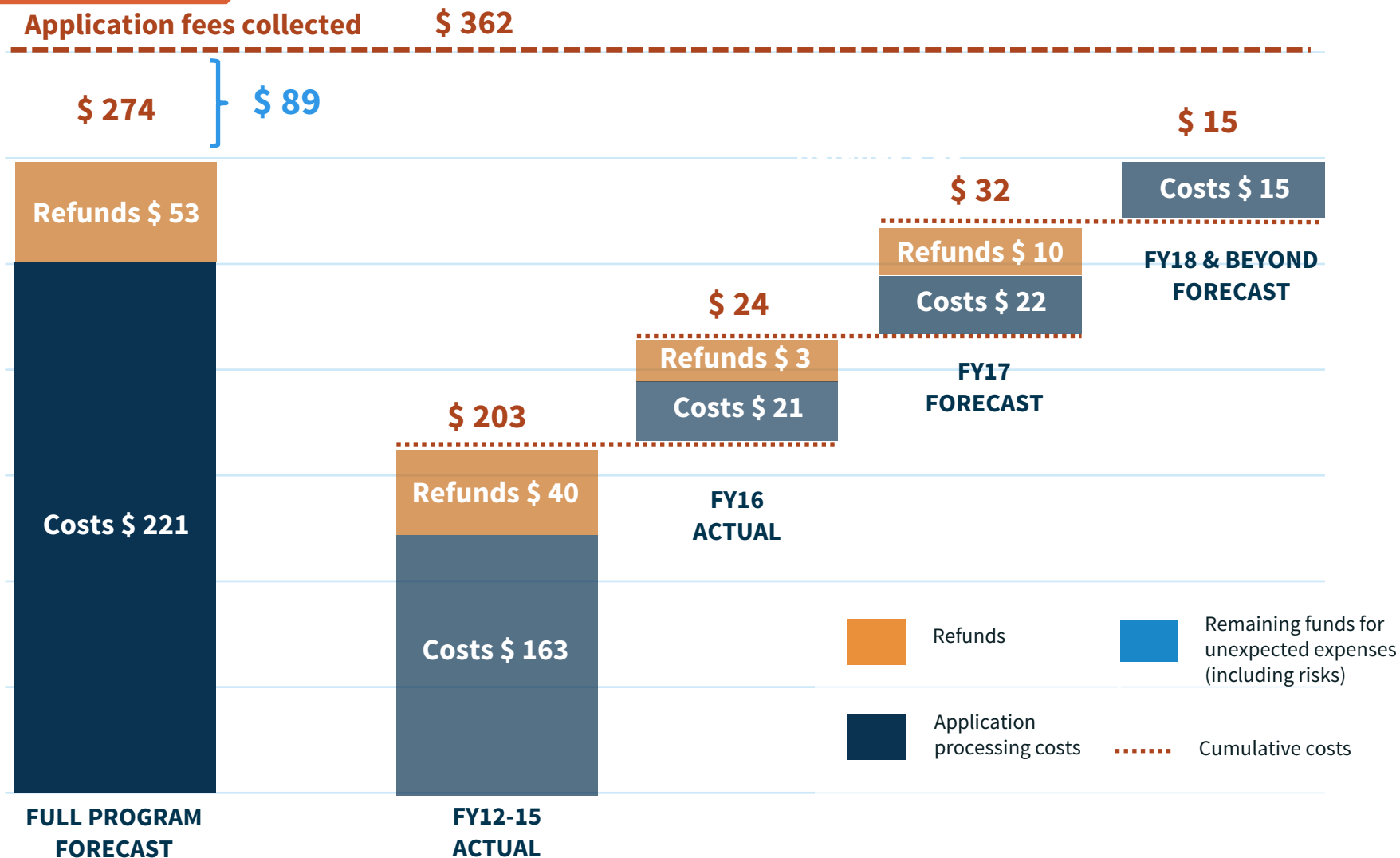
