

Dear Registrar,

This is a reminder that the <u>global amendment</u> to the 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA Global Amendment) will become **effective on 05 April 2024**. You may view the changes in further detail via the redline posted on the <u>2013 Registrar Accreditation</u> Agreement webpage.

What does this mean for you? 05 April 2024 is the starting point for compliance with the new requirements. The RAA Global Amendment enhances the existing provisions in Section 3.18 of the RAA by requiring registrars to promptly take reasonable and appropriate action to stop or otherwise disrupt DNS Abuse. Please refer to the 2024 Global Amendment webpage for a more detailed explanation of these changes.

In connection with the RAA Global Amendment, ICANN has also issued an <u>Advisory</u> that provides guidance on the interpretation of and compliance with the new requirements once such requirements become effective.
