Dear Zhang Jun,

Please be advised that as of 20 September 2018, Shenzhen Domainstar Technology Co., Limited ("Shenzhen Domainstar Technology") is in breach of its 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 12 April 2017 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

1. Shenzhen Domainstar Technology's failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Please refer to the attachment for details regarding this breach.

Additional Concerns

Due to the receipt of rejection notices from Shenzhen Domainstar Technology's primary contact email addresses, ICANN will also send this notice of breach to alternate contact email addresses.

ICANN requests that Shenzhen Domainstar Technology cure these breaches by 11 October 2018, 21 days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

- 1. Provide ICANN with corrective and preventative action(s), including implementation date(s), to ensure:
 - a. timely response to ICANN Contractual Compliance matters;
 - b. Shenzhen Domainstar Technology's contact information is up to date; and
 - c. timely payment of its ICANN fees; and



2. Pay all past and currently due accreditation fees.

If Shenzhen Domainstar Technology fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 11 October 2018, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.

Failure to pay accreditation fees

Section 3.9 of the RAA requires registrars to timely pay accreditation fees to ICANN, consisting of yearly and variable fees. Shenzhen Domainstar Technology owes ICANN past due accreditation fees, in breach of Section 3.9 of the RAA.
